

To facilitate the validation of documentary requirements such as but not limited to, SPS-IC, Health Certificate, MAV certification, Bill of Lading, Invoice, and Packing List for processing of cargo release at Veterinary Quarantine Stations-in various international ports, during the Enhanced Community Quarantine period, the Bureau of Animal Industry hereby prescribes the following remedial process:

1. The Importer/Broker will submit the documents to BAI-NVQS which will validate the authenticity of SPS-IC, Health Certificate, MAV certification, Bill of Lading, Invoice, and Packing List.

2. The BAI-NVQS will send an email to the concerned VQS port with attached scanned

copies of validated documents.

3. The VQS quarantine personnel will submit these documents to the Bureau of Customs (BOC) examiner for tagging and further processing.

In consideration of the health and safety of individuals from the livestock production sector as well as the employees who process the application for local shipping permit of live animals including semen, animal products and by-products while the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in Luzon is in effect, the validity of Veterinary Health Certificate (VHC) which is three (3) days from the date of issuance as specified in DA Administrative Order No.5 s.2019 will be temporarily extended to seven (7) days. Counting of the seven day extension shall commence from the date of issuance of the VHC.

This provisional extension is applicable until April 30, 2020, which will coincide with the last day of the extended ECQ pursuant to Memorandum from the Executive Secretary dated April 7, 2020.
